Non-Profit Status Update


We have submitted our paperwork for non-profit status (form 1023) to the IRS and are hopeful that we will receive our tax-exempt status later this year.

First IWA Aid Mission Plans Evolving

We are currently organizing a volunteer medical and humanitarian aid mission to Cambodia for late 2012 or early 2013. The project will establish a temporary medical clinic, provide nutritional and hygiene support and education, and assist with repair/construction of local infrastructure of a small community in Cambodia. Volunteers will have the opportunity to help people in need overseas while learning more about this ancient culture. The trip will be of 2 week duration and will include teachings and practice of insight meditation. Organization for this project currently includes identifying communities in need in Cambodia, exploring partnerships with organizations and individuals, research, recruiting volunteers, and fundraising.

How to get involved with IWA:

1. **Volunteer** - Insight World Aid is in need of volunteers. We need both people with medical training and qualifications and also people with
